---This Day in History---

Nov. 2, 1962 - During the Cuban Missile Crisis, President John F. Kennedy announced on TV, "the Soviet bases in Cuba are being dismantled, their missiles and related equipment being crated, and the fixed installations at these sites are being destroyed."

Nov. 3, 1957 - Soviet Russia launched the world's first inhabited space capsule, Sputnik II, which carried a dog named Laika.

Nov. 6, 1860 - Abraham Lincoln was elected as the 16th U.S. President

Nov. 7, 1944 - President Franklin D. Roosevelt was elected to an unprecedented fourth term.

Nov. 10, 1775 - The U.S. Marine Corps was established as part of the U.S. Navy.

Nov. 13, 1956 - The U.S. Supreme Court ruled that racial segregation on public buses was unconstitutional.

Nov. 19, 1863 - President Abraham Lincoln delivered the Gettysburg Address during ceremonies dedicating 17 acres of the Gettysburg Battlefield as a National Cemetery.

November 25, 1963 - Three days after his assassination, John F. Kennedy was buried with full military honors at Arlington National Cemetery.

November 26, 1789 - The first American holiday occurred, proclaimed by President George Washington to be Thanksgiving Day.
